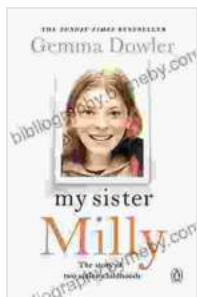


My Sister Milly: A Heartbreaking Account of a Family's Loss

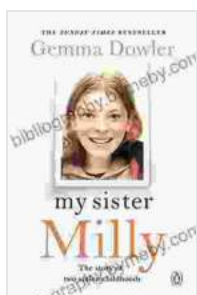

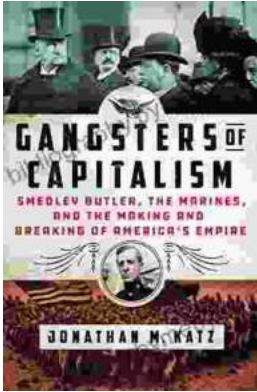

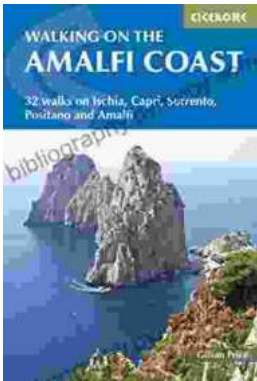
