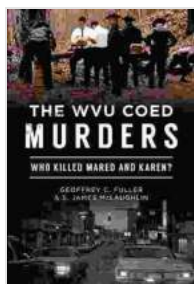


The WVU Coed Murders: A Haunting True Crime Story

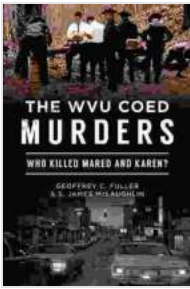

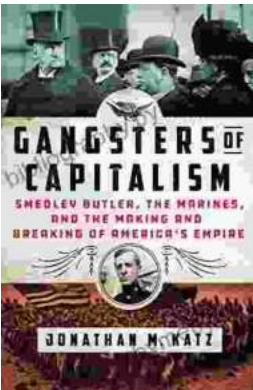

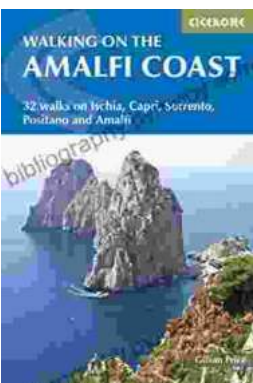
